Community Health Caregiving Programs offered by Kanawha Valley Senior Services encompass the Veteran's Administration, Medicaid Aged and Disabled Waiver, Personal Care, and Lighthouse. Each program has distinct medical and financial eligibility criteria, as well as varying levels of care, but they all aim to support individuals in their homes, promoting independence and dignity.

The Medicaid Aged and Disabled Waiver (ADW) Program provides in-home and community services to individuals 18 years of age and older who are medically and financially eligible. Medical eligibility is based on a Medical Necessity Evaluation Request (MNER) which must be completed by the applicant and the applicant's physician. Financial eligibility is determined by your local county Department of Health and Human Resources office.

Services in the ADW Program that are provided to recipients include Case Management, a Personal Attendant to help with activities of daily living, necessary transportation and an RN who completes assessments to ensure that the recipient's plan of care meets his/her needs

# **MACARONI SALAD**

# INGREDIENTS

- 2/3 cup low-fat sour cream
- 1/2 cup light mayonnaise
- 2 tablespoons chopped fresh parsley
- 2 TBSP sweet pickle relish
- 1 TBSP spicy brown mustard
- 1/2 TSP white pepper



- 4 cups cooked elbow macaroni (about 8 ounces uncooled pasta)
- 1 cup sliced green peas, thawed
- 3/4 (3 ounces) diced reduced fat sharp cheddar cheese
- 1/2 cup diced carrot
- 1/2 cup diced green bell pepper
- 1/2 cup diced celery
- 1/2 cup diced lean ham (2 ounces)

# INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Combine first 6 ingredients in a large bowl and stir well.
- 2. Add macaroni and remaining ingredients.
- 3. Toss well to coat.
- 4. Cover and chill before serving.

# **Medicare and Durable Medical Equipment**

## What kind of durable medical equipment (DME) does Medicare cover?

Medicare usually covers DME if:



It's durable, meaning it can withstand repeated use



It serves a medical purpose



It's appropriate and needed for use in the home, although you can also use it outside the home



It's likely to last for three years or more

Examples of DME: Wheelchairs, walkers, hospital beds, power scooters, portable oxygen equipment, orthotics, catheters (if your need for them is permanent), prosthetics, certain diabetes supplies (including glucose monitors)

### What kind of DME does Medicare not cover?

- · Equipment to mainly help you outside the home
- · Items intended only to make things more convenient or comfortable
- · Items that you throw away after one use
- Items that you don't use with equipment
- Modifications to your home
- Equipment not for use in the home

For example: Air conditioners, incontinence pads, surgical facemasks, or oscillating beds.

Note: Some Medicare Advantage Plans may cover minor home modifications or other items as a supplemental benefit.
